

## Florida Announces Need for 1,310 More Nursing Home Beds

On October 4, the Florida Agency for Health Care Administration announced a need for 1,310 additional nursing home beds throughout the state. The announcement represents the largest prediction of bed need since the state lifted a 14-year moratorium on the development of additional nursing home beds in 2014. The spike in need is due to high utilization of existing beds and expected growth in elderly residents in pockets of the state.

The announcement invites interested skilled nursing facility developers to seek a certificate of need to meet the predicted need. Interested parties may submit letters announcing their intent to file CON applications if they submit them to the Agency by October 21. Applications would have to be completed by December 26, 2019 with a decision expected from the Agency on February 21, 2020.

The opportunity comes at an interesting time for the skilled nursing community as they transition to a new Patient Driven Patient Model (PDPM) payment methodology. It will be interesting to see what models of care will be proposed by applicants, and which models will be preferred by state regulators.
